





ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In order to be eligible to participate in the Call for Ideas, launched by MUBAS each applicant must meet all of the following criteria as of 1st September 2023:

- Applicant must have a new business idea.
- Be an individual over 18 years of age and under 35 years of age.
- Applicants need to be Malawian citizens with a National ID number.
- Have a traceable physical residential location within the District of Blantyre
- Have attained an education level to a minimum of JCE.
- Be willing to register their business at the appropriate time.
- Have received their latest educational qualification (for example JCE, a course with a TEVET institution etc) within the past five years.
- Demonstrate an intention to grow their business in future and provide employment opportunities for Malawians.

- The product/service of your idea can only be accepted for the following sectors: manufacturing, mining, finance, health, agriculture, transport, tourism, built environment, energy.
- Should be able to spend full time for the training and support sessions provided by MUBAS.
- Be able to cover all necessary transportation, food and accommodation costs in order to participate in the programme.
- Should be able to provide updates on their activities and progress during their incubation phase.
- The applicant should not have been involved in an incubation or acceleration before or be currently under incubation or applying to another incubation programme.
- The product/service cannot be focused on alcohol, gambling, or tobacco sectors.
- The product/service should not have detrimental environmental impacts, if it does mitigation measures need to be stated.
