MALAWI UNIVERSITY OF BUSINESS AND APPLIED SCIENCES

The Malawi University of Business and Applied Sciences (MUBAS) (Formerly University of Malawi - The Polytechnic) has developed a multidisciplinary **Master of Science in Sustainable Energy** with support from the United Kingdom's Department for International Development (DfID) through its Transforming Energy Access - Learning Partnership (TEA-LP) Project and from The Government of Liechtenstein through The Liechtenstein Institute for Strategic Development (LISD).

With Malawi's clean energy sector set to grow rapidly in the years ahead, this all-new 2-year multidisciplinary Masters degree programme will provide professional skills in engineering, technology, economics, management, policy and entrepreneurship. The Masters programme is structured into two streams (Energy Access and Energy Management), comprising 8 taught modules in first year and a Thesis module (research) in second year. The student will take 5 common modules and 3 stream-specific modules.

Entry Requirements

Applicants must have a relevant Bachelor's degree (**with at least a strong pass**) in science or engineering or renewable energy or built environment or technical education for Energy Access stream. For the Energy Management stream, the applicants must have a relevant Bachelor's degree (**with at least a strong pass**) in science or engineering or built environment, or renewable energy or technical education or commerce or social science. The qualifications must be obtained from institutions that are accredited by recognised Higher Education Regulators.

Successful applicants will be required to pay a tuition fee of **US\$6,500** Malawi Kwacha equivalent for the programme duration of 2 years. The Programme is offered on block release and on non-residential basis.

A complete application **MUST INCLUDE**:

1. An application form completed and a CV;
2. **1 Academic Reference** letter and **1 professional reference** letter;
3. **Certified Academic** Transcript;
4. **Certified copies** of original certificates by a commissioner of oath or Lawyers (Notary public);
5. A non-refundable application fee of **MK10, 000** for Malawian applicants and **USD25.00** for international students.

APPLICATION METHOD

1. Put all your necessary application documents in one folder on your computer e.g. filled application form, relevant certified copies of degree, academic transcripts, letters from two referees (academic reference and professional reference);and an original bank deposit slip for application fee;
2. Create a zip folder on your computer;
